

## Dr Srdjan Krco

Dr Srdjan Krco holds a PhD degree from the University of Novi Sad for the work in the application of mobile communications in health monitoring. He founded DunavNET in 2006 and is currently managing and driving research activities in the company, particularly focusing on smart city and smart agriculture domains. Previously, since 2000, Srdjan was with Ericsson where he held a number of positions (senior research engineer, system manager, project manager) and has worked in and managed a number of product development and research projects, focusing on M2M, Internet of Things and their application in various domains including the smart cities. He has participated in a number of FP7 and H2020 projects (SocloTal, CLIPS, IoT Lab, SENSEI, Smart-Santander, etc.) and is currently coordinating TagItSmart! H2020 project. Srdjan is active in the International IoT Forum and Alliance for IoT Innovation (AIOTI), contributing to working groups on smart cities and smart agriculture. He has published more than 50 papers in international journals and at international conferences as well as more than 10 patents. In 2007 he received the Innovation engineer of the Year Award in Ireland from the Institute of Engineers of Ireland. In 2006, Srdjan initiated summer school on IoT and its applications which is since held annually with participation of over 500 young researchers.
